**1** → **8** Identifying inter-sectoral initiatives supporting early childhood, especially for children from disadvantaged environments.

- common protocol

- survey template transferrable to the whole consortium

**7** → **20** Identification of good practices regarding collaboration and co-training

- diagnosis of the needs (children, families) in the three regions of experimentation
- treatment of questionnaire results
- cross-sector good practices guide for the inclusion of disadvantaged children
